NCCP Certification Process – Competition Introduction

-1st. You should already have a profile and NCCP number

2nd. You can monitor your profile and credits on the locker, www.thelocker.coach.ca

- If not already registered, register as a Coach with Boxing BC and provide a criminal record check and Making Ethical Decisions (MED) evaluation

3rd. Take the in classroom Boxing Specific Competition Introduction Coaching Module hosted by Boxing BC (Event Calendar)

4th. Sign up for the Competition Introduction Multisport modules on the ViaSport website, www.viasport.ca or thelocker.coach.ca

These Multisport modules are:

- Teaching and Learning
- Basic Mental Skills
- Design a Basic Sport Program

5th. Apply to Boxing Canada for Evaluation and Certification as a Competition Introduction Coach.
