

Instruction Beginner Coach Education Certification Process

NCCP Certification Process - Instruction Beginner

1st. Create a profile and obtain an NCCP number on Coach.ca webpage HERE

2nd. If not already registered, register as a Coach with Boxing BC <u>HERE</u>
(In order to register as a coach, you will need to also have done a <u>criminal record check</u> and completed your <u>Making Ethical Decisions (MED)</u> course

3rd. Take the in classroom Boxing Specific Instruction Beginner Coaching Module hosted by Boxing BC (Event Page)

4th. Sign up for the Instruction Beginner Coach Multisport modules on the ViaSport website, <u>www.viasport.ca</u> or on www.coach.ca <u>elearning page</u>

These multi-sport modules are:

- Making Ethical Decisions
- Nutrition
- · Planning a Practice

5th. Mentor under a minimum of a Competition Instruction Level coach for 1 year

6th. Apply to Boxing Canada for Evaluation and Certification as an Instruction Beginner Level Coach.

Note* - To keep your coaching status active, Competition Introduction Coaches need to maintain 10 Professional Development points, every 5 years.
